

## NOTICE TO ALL KERNS RESIDENTS



Please be advised that as of April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2007, all Kerns residents who plan on starting a fire to burn in an incinerator, brush piles, grass (yard), windrows, field/crops and fireworks will have to get a 'FIRE PERMIT'.

The 'FIRE PERMITS' will be available at the township office at 903303 Hanbury Rd., New Liskeard at NO COST.

Under the Municipal Act, and By-law No. 2007-03 and section 5 of O. Reg. 207/96 of the Forest Fires Prevention Act, a 'FIRE PERMIT' is needed for burning under certain conditions. The terms and conditions of the 'FIRE PERMITS' are well described in the 'Fire Permit' form.

Every person guilty of an offence against this By-law, upon conviction, therefore shall be subject to a fine of not more than one thousand (\$1,000.00) dollars exclusive of costs.

**REMEMBER:** Between April 1<sup>st</sup> and October 31<sup>st</sup>, a Fire Permit is now mandatory for burning (effective April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2007).
