SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

1. The permittee shall keep this permit at the site of the burning operation conducted under the permit.
2. The person in charge of the burning operation conducted under the permit shall produce and show the permit to any officer whenever requested by that officer.
3. The fire is to be started two (2) hours before sunset, or later, and is to be extinguished two (2) hours after sunrise the following day, or earlier. Burning at any other time requires a specific permit from the Chief Fire Official.
4. The amount to be burned at any time shall not exceed 1 hectare or 2 piles.
5. All slash and land-clearing debris shall be in piles or windrows, separated by a distance of at least 9 metres. Windrows shall not exceed 6 metres in length.
6. The permittee shall have at the location of the fire a minimum of 2 persons and firefighting equipment in serviceable conditions.
7. Burning may not be conducted in winds greater than 15 kph.
8. The permittee shall assume full responsibility for the burning operation conducted under the permit.
